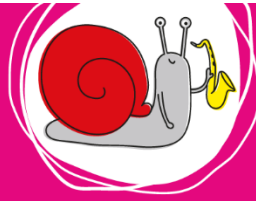
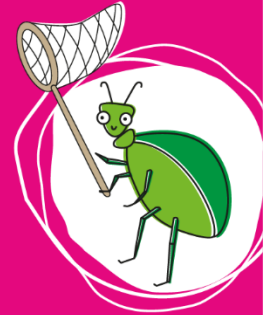

Wishing Stars Craft Activity



Aim:

We would love all of you to get crafty and creative at home and share your pieces of art with us. Follow this worksheet to make and decorate your very own wishing stars of what you would like to do/ achieve after lockdown.

What you need

First of all get your craft kit together. Have a dig around and see what you have at home, don't worry if you don't have everything, just use what you've got!

- Card (you could use plain /coloured card /shoe box /cereal box)
- Pencil or pen, scissors and glue
- Paint and brush
- Colouring pens, pencils and/or crayons
- Decorative bits and bobs to decorate your star
- A piece of string, ribbon or thread.

Step 1

- Draw your star shape on your card. You can either draw your own, or if you need a bit of help you can find lots of star templates by asking your grown up to google: *A4 Star Template*.
- Next, with the help of a grown up, cut out the star shape with scissors - the bigger the star the better!
- Paint/ colour your star anyway you like, then leave this to dry.

Step 2

- Think about what wish you are going to write on your star.
We would love you to complete the following sentence

I wish

OR

You can do a poem /creative writing starting with the same sentence: I wish

Step 3

- Decorate your star however you wish. Get creative add sparkles, feathers, stickers anything you like for you piece of art leave to dry.

Step 4

- Add your sentence or creative writing to your wishing star.
- Ask a grown up to help you punch a hole in your star, then using your long piece of string, hang your star up!
- This could be on a picture hook or off a window handle, or with a piece of blue-tac or tape.

Step 5

- Look at the brilliant star you've made!
- Now, cross your fingers make a wish.
